CONGRATULATIONS AND THANK YOU FOR BOOKING WITH US!

MUST READ INFO:

The cost of this trip is **\$3600** for single occupancy. **PRICE INCLUDES** six days fishing, seven nights of hotel accommodation, all meals, non alcoholic beverages and beer, and a Mexican fishing license. **NOT INCLUDED** are airport transfers, airline tickets, hard liquor, tackle, flies, and tips. **You can buy flies from me in advance and/or purchase them at the lodge.** Bring dollars for tips \$50 (minimum) *per day* to the captains + \$25 for bait *per day*.. At the end of the week please tip \$75 (minimum) to our incredible cooks and \$40 (minimum) for maid service.

GROUP AIRPORT TRANSFER to and from **San Jose del Cabo** is about \$120 per person each way, payable upon arrival, if you travel with the group. Be aware: If you are traveling solo, because you are arriving very late or departing very early, or traveling on a different day, transfer is about \$180 each way.. We *try* to coordinate our flights to **arrive before 1PM, and depart after 1:30 PM. Betty or Carlos, will be waiting for you with a sign with my name on it.** Please send your flight schedule in a **SEPARATE EMAIL** subject **FLIGHT ITINERARY** when you book it. Your trip dates are arrival and departure (fly) dates.

The driver will take you to a large supermarket in Los Barriles so that you can buy anything else you need: They have a nice selection of spirits and wines. We do have some selections in our small local markets. You are allowed to bring two liters of alcohol into Mexico. We have an open bar situation where there may be some spirits or wine left over from the previous group. Basically, one contributes a favorite spirit to this bar and we make each other drinks. There is also a bar for purchasing fine cocktails and IPAs at the hotel, open until 9:30 PM.

TRAVEL INSURANCE IS HIGHLY ADVISABLE Most airlines offer travel insurance when you book your tickets. It is very reasonable and will cover your costs if an emergency arises at home, or baggage doesn't arrive here. You can also purchase Medi-Vac insurance for a reasonable price. [Global Rescue](#) is our affiliate and has a great track record. This part of Mexico is not dangerous, but medical emergency coverage and evacuation services are best obtained beforehand. You will be fishing! *The most common last minute cancellation is caused by a medical emergency before the trip.* **Protect yourself!**

RESERVATION POLICY: Rooms are assigned first come first serve based on postmark as registration and waiver with 50 % deposit is received. Please send a deposit within two weeks of notifying me that you want a spot. Payment in full is due **90 Days** prior to the trip date payable in US dollars by cash, check or money order. Sorry, no credit cards or PayPal accepted.

BEGINNING THE DAY AFTER YOUR ARRIVAL: We get up an hour before sunrise for a hearty breakfast. *We (the fishermen)* pack our pre-prepared sandwiches or burritos, chips and drinks for each pair of fishing partners. We load the lunch boxes into the van and head for the beach to meet our captains at sunrise. Protective rod socks are provided. We are normally back on the beach at about 2 o'clock and head back to the hotel for cleaning out our ice chests, rod rinsing, water bottle refilling, siesta, snacks, casting lessons, fly tying or leader building. Cocktails anytime and dinner is at 6:30 or 7 PM. As mentioned, there is some beach fishing in front of the hotel, especially in the late afternoon. An 8w or 9w with an intermediate or sink tip will do the job.

This is the one trip where the variety of fish is so extensive that it is not uncommon to fish with three rods in a day. Please see the tackle list. Inquire about equipment rental if necessary. There are no dumb questions!
